It's also the time to get festive - and the stores are overflowing with quality new boards to fulfill that wish list you left for Santa. Heck - I know which one shows up under my tree...

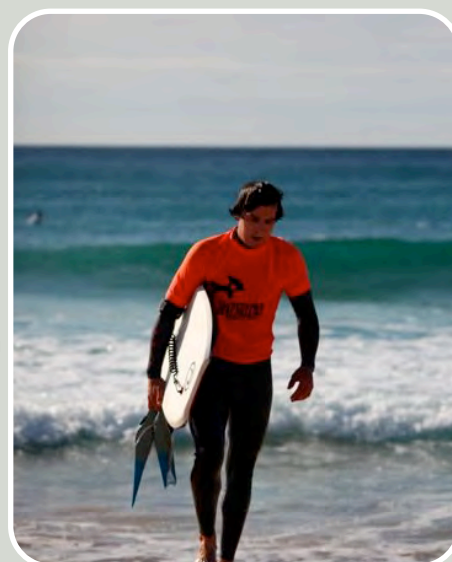

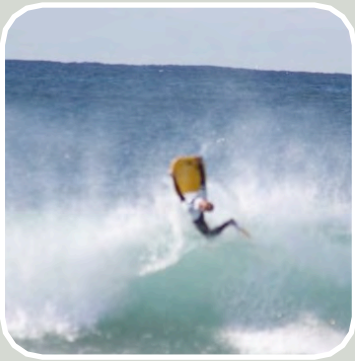
When you only have one day of the entire month for every possible factor to come together, well, it's a big gamble...

Hands down the best beach breaks I've ever seen. Fly to Mexico City, then connect to Puerto Escondido (don't get the 18hr bus like I did). Stay right on the beach, and do day trips to Punta Colorada - a beach where only bodyboarders are welcome (you'll see why!)

When a company from outside of the tight little bodyboard industry decides to take an interest in the sport, news of it spreads pretty quickly. For example, the whole booging world is now talking about how Coke are hosting the next Pipe comp in Hawaii. So it's little wonder that everywhere I go riders are asking me how we managed to partner up with such cool brands.

Guzman y Gomez was founded here a few years back by Steven Marks, who grew up learning to love Mexican food thanks to a few close friends he had while growing up. Only thing was, that when Steve moved to Sydney, he couldn't believe the the lack of REAL Mexican food on offer.

And the man was right. Even most of the stuff you got from a “restaurant” looked and tasted like it came from a supermarket pack. So he

brought out a Mexican chef to set up the menu, and what is now on offer is hands down some of the best food you will find anywhere.

Last summer I spent 3 weeks stumbling through different regions of Mexico, and fell in love with their waves, their beer, and their food.

Luckily for you, they have the best food outside of Mexico itself, and are now licensed to serve Corona's and Margarita's.

I recommend the Spicy Chicken Guerrero Burrito, which goes down all too easily after a surf. Oh, and if you want to throw some more genuine taste into your meal, go to the condiment bar and get some coriander and onion to throw in your taco and burrito (no Mexican mother would feed her kids any other way!).

Other than discounts, they hook up MBB with a heap of prizes, like shirts, hats, stickers and vouchers. Best food in Sydney. Get some!
